### Scripture - Exodus 16:1-10

In what ways was the Israelites' situation similar to the one we're currently facing? Where do you see complaining in the midst of this pandemic? Where do you see God's provision?

### "The Desert Song"

In this song, we proclaimed that *"In every season, You are still God and I have a reason to sing."* In the midst of the turmoil of this past week, have you found a reason to sing? Has God blessed you through the kindness of others? Have you been blessed by opportunities that you have had to serve or offer kindness?

### "Blessings"

In this solo, Melody sang the following words: *"What if my greatest disappointments or the aching of this life is the revealing of a greater thirst this world can't satisfy?"* Have the forced sacrifices and changes to your everyday routine helped you sense what is truly important in life? What do you truly "thirst" for today?

### Message - "How Long?"

Today's message is based on Psalm 13. Paul interpreted this Psalm as one that gives us permission to do three things:

**1) Be H\_\_\_\_\_ with God**

What are some questions you have for God in the midst of the coronavirus?

**2) Be H\_\_\_\_\_ before God**

Are there areas of your life where you need to submit to your limits and say, "I don't know"?

**3) Have H\_\_\_\_\_ in God**

Like the Psalmist, even in the midst of trouble can you still say, "I trust in your unfailing love. I will rejoice...I will sing to the Lord because he is good to me"? If so, how?
